



### AJ Burnett Thanks Lord Jesus Christ For Guaranteed Contracts - *The Brushback*

TORONTO--AJ Burnett is not normally a religious man, but the oft-injured pitcher was inspired to get on his knees yesterday and thank the Lord Jesus Christ for guaranteed contracts. Burnett signed a 5-year, \$55 million contract with the Toronto Blue Jays this year and is now on the disabled list.

"Thank you, thank you, thank you Jesus. Thank you for guaranteed contracts," Burnett said as he sat in the trainer's room with his arm in a sling. "Oh my goodness, without guaranteed contracts I would not be getting paid right now. I would not have gotten paid in the past, either, when I got my Tommy John surgery. This is why baseball is better than football. Once you put pen to paper, it's all over. Now all I have to do is sit back, relax, and wait to get better. No hurry, though. It's usually best not to rush these things."

The Blue Jays took a calculated risk in signing Burnett this offseason, as he has a surgically repaired shoulder to go along with a mediocre career record. However the Blue Jays were desperate for pitching and made the move anyway, outbidding all other suitors by a large amount.

Burnett assured the team they made the right decision at the time and still feels that way today.

"It was a fair contract that I got. JP [Riccardi, Jays GM] did the right thing," he said. "When you want a player, you've got to go out there and get him. That \$55 million really showed me that I was wanted. A lot of other clubs would have been frightened away by my reconstructed shoulder. Now those clubs are laughing and I'm rolling in money, so I guess...they were right. Wait a minute. That whole thing came out wrong."

Burnett has only pitched one game for the Blue Jays this year so far. While he is thanking the Good Lord for guaranteed contracts, JP Riccardi is cursing their very existence.
